### **Job Summary:**

The part time driver is responsible for transporting students, using vans with a capacity of fewer than 10, who are enrolled at MeANS. This may include daily transportation to and from school for our day students and/or transportation of the on-campus students to and from drop-off points where their parents will pick them up

### **Duties and Responsibilities - Custodial:**

- Pick up and drop off MeANS student to and from school.
- Reports all incidents of work-related accident/illness within 24 hours; maintain a safe work environment; ensure that a safe environment is maintained in the workplace by adhering to all safety rules and requirements (Safety Policies) and report any safety hazards to immediate supervisor.
- Ensure that the building(s) are properly secured each night.
- Demonstrates awareness and sensitivity to the cultural and socioeconomic characteristics of the service population
- All other duties as may be reasonably assigned by the supervisor.

### **Qualifications:**

Cooperative attitude: reliable and honest. Must have a high school diploma or equivalent. Satisfactory reference, background, and health checks. Must have a valid Maine driver's license.

### **Salary/Benefits:**

Wage and benefit package as determined by the Board of Directors.

### **Other Relevant Information:**

\$100,000/\$300,000 automobile liability insurance coverage if transporting Good Will-Hinckley student.
